A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL TO SIGN AN APPLICATION FOR CDBG FUNDS

Whereas, the Village of Haigler, Nebraska, is an eligible unit of a general local government authorized to file an application under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended for Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program, and,

Whereas, the Village of Haigler, Nebraska, has obtained its citizens' comments on community development and housing needs; and has conducted public hearing(s) upon the proposed application and received favorable public comment respecting the application which for an amount of \$23,000 for The Village of Haigler, Dundy County, Nebraska to develop a community development plan as well as a comprehensive municipal code review that will guide the community's growth and development for years to come. The Village of Haigler does not have a comprehensive plan, community development plan or strategic plan on file and the Village Municipal Code Book was adopted in 1989. These critical planning initiatives will establish the strategic framework necessary for addressing the village's housing, infrastructure, economic development and community service needs while ensuring benefits primarily reach low to moderate income residents. Project activities will include development of a community development plan as well as a comprehensive municipal code review. Project impacts may include planning guidance to the village board, community members and businesses. These plans will assist in development of infrastructure and growth within the village. Updating the Village of Haigler Municipal Code will address the needs of the village community members, businesses and tourists to ensure a safe and healthy environment. Total project costs are estimated at \$25,300, including \$3,000 for general administration and \$22,000 for project cost. Funding sources include a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for \$23,000 and a match from the Village of \$2,300. The project will primarily benefit low to moderate income (LMI) persons. Planning efforts will be completed within two (2) years. No persons or businesses will be displaced as a result of the project activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAIGLER, NEBRASKA:

That the Board Chairman be authorized and directed to proceed with the formulation of any and all contracts, documents or other memoranda between Village of Haigler and the Nebraska Department of Economic Development so as to effect acceptance of the grant application.
