

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2025-01
OF THE VILLAGE OF HAIGLER, NEBRASKA**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAIGLER, NEBRASKA, SETTING TRASH SERVICE RATES; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS; TO PROVIDE WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHAIRPERSON AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAIGLER, NEBRASKA:

SECTION 1. SOLID WASTE RATES. That there shall be, and there hereby is, established a garbage pickup service charge for the use of and for the service supplied by the Village of Haigler, Dundy County, Nebraska, based on monthly rates for residential and commercial properties. The charges shall be billed monthly and are based on one bin or dumpster access within the Village for residential properties. Commercial accounts have the option to participate in shared dumpster access or to have a 2 yard or 3 yard dumpster. The monthly rate applicable for weekly garbage pickup service provided shall be as follows:

Residential	\$30.00 per month
Commercial - Shared Dumpster	\$30.00 per month
Commercial - 2 Yard Dumpster	\$74.10 per month
Commercial - 3 Yard Dumpster	\$88.81 per month

Per agreement with Waste Connections of Nebraska, Inc., there is no charge for solid waste removal for local Churches and Non-Profit organizations, nor does the Village affiliate itself with the American Legion's solid waste removal.

Waste Connections of Nebraska, Inc. provides each residential account with one bin or dumpster access within the Village. Commercial accounts are provided a dumpster to share or one 2 yard or 3 yard dumpster; both bins and dumpsters are to remain at the location where they are delivered.

Garbage pickup service provided through the Village of Haigler shall be by contract established by and between the Village of Haigler and Waste Connections of Nebraska, Inc. to provide said service.

SECTION 2. That all other Ordinances or sections passed and approved prior or the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this Ordinance and in conflict with its provisions, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That three-fifths of the Board of Trustees voted to suspend the requirement that this Ordinance be read by title on three different days.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, approval, and publication or posting as required by law.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and available for public inspection during normal Village office hours.
